



CLUB ADMISSION AND RESERVATION POLICY

Member. Texas A&M Lettermen's Association Active Member or Life Member and in good standing may request admission to the Coach Jackie Sherrill Lettermen's Club.

- Access to the Club on special event dates will be based on a multi-tiered priority reservation system established by the Lettermen's Association Board of Directors.
- Member priority ranking will be based on lifetime giving (12th Man Foundation priority points) as well as gifts to the Lettermen's Facility Campaign.
- Capital campaign gifts of \$25,000 and above dedicated to the Lettermen's Facility Campaign qualifies member for Member Club Donor Preferred Access ranking through December 31, 2024.
- The multi-tiered priority reservation system will be activated online on a specified date preceding each event.
- Member is eligible to request up to 4 admissions (the Member plus up to 3 guests) on special event dates. Member and guests must be in possession of a valid football game ticket to enter Club.
- Admissions must be requested on a game-by-game basis through the aforementioned reservation system.
- Admission is non-transferrable.
- Member must accompany guests.
- A reserved number of admissions will be set aside on special event days for engagement efforts, i.e. reunions.
- Access to the Club is available only to Members and guests of Members with a valid football game ticket.

In accordance with TABC regulations, alcoholic beverages are not allowed to leave the premises.

The Texas A&M Lettermen's Association emphasizes a commitment to promoting responsible drinking, and any instances of underage drinking will be dealt with in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, per TABC.

While food service will not be offered within the Club, Members and guests have the option to enter the stadium concourse, purchase food items and return to the Club. We kindly encourage all Members and guests to responsibly dispose of their trash and contribute to maintaining a clean and enjoyable environment for everyone.
