2025 CLUB RESERVATION AND ADMISSION

Admission to the *Coach Jackie Sherrill Lettermen's Club* on home football game dates and special event dates is governed by a reservation process and admission policy established by the Texas A&M Lettermen's Association Board of Directors. A Texas A&M Lettermen's Association Lifetime Member, Annual Active Member, or Active Associate Member and in good standing may request admission to the Club.

GROUPS:

TIER 1	LIFETIME MEMBERS	Fully paid current life membership
TIER 2	ACTIVE ANNUAL MEMBERS	Fully paid current annual* membership
TIER 3	ACTIVE ASSOCIATE MEMBERS	Fully paid current annual* or lifetime membership

**Annual Membership cycle: January 1 – December 31*

RESERVATION PROCESS:

- **Tier 1** group has the first opportunity to reserve admissions through a reservation link shared via email ten (10) days prior to each home football game date or special event date.
- **Tier 2** group is permitted to reserve admissions beginning four (4) days prior to each home football game date or special event date.
- **Tier 3** group is permitted to reserve admissions beginning two (2) days prior to each home football game date or special event date.
- Member is eligible to request up to four (4) admissions (Member + up to 3 guests). Guest types include adults, children (3-17 years old), with no exceptions. Infants/toddlers, 36 months and younger, will not require a wristband for Club admission. Member and all guests, including infants, must be in possession of a valid football game ticket to enter Club.

Once the maximum capacity allowance is reached for the Club, the reservation system will automatically close for the coordinating game date or special event.

Reservation will be released if Member fails to check-in by the end of the 1st quarter of football game.

ADMISSION POLICY (non-transferable):

- A valid photo ID is required for all Members with Club reservations to enter the Club on gameday. No exceptions. Please have ID ready when checking in.
- Guests must check-in at the same time as the Member, with no exception.
- Admissions must be requested on a game-by-game basis through the aforementioned reservation system.
- Member must accompany guests. This includes accompanying guests on initial entry and re-entering the Club via stadium concourse entrance near Section 119.

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CONDUCT & EXPECTATIONS:

The Texas A&M Lettermen's Association is dedicated to fostering an enjoyable environment for all Members and guests. **Dress Code: Members and guests are required to wear Aggie Spirit attire or neutral attire that reflects respect for the Club's traditions and environment.** To ensure a positive atmosphere, it is imperative that all Members follow Club policies, and all Members and guests conduct themselves in a well-mannered, and courteous manner towards Members, guests, and staff. Failure to adhere to these policies and expectations may lead to removal, admission suspension or termination of Club privileges. We appreciate everyone's commitment to creating a welcoming and respectful community within our organization. Member must directly and actively supervise young guests/children. Any Member or guest failing to properly supervise young guests/children will be asked to refrain from bringing young guests/children in the future.

FOOD & BEVERAGES:

The Texas A&M Lettermen's Association is pleased to offer complimentary non-alcoholic and limited alcoholic beverages in the Club, starting two hours prior to kick-off and concluding at the end of the third quarter of the football game. We encourage Members and guests to show their appreciation for the exceptional service provided by our bartenders by considering a gratuity. In accordance with TABC regulations, alcoholic beverages are not allowed to leave the premises. The Association emphasizes a commitment to promoting responsible drinking, and any instances of underage drinking will be dealt with in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, per TABC.

While food service is not offered in the Club, Members and guests have the option to enter the stadium concourse, purchase food items and return to the Club. We kindly encourage all Members and guests to responsibly dispose of trash and contribute to maintaining a clean and enjoyable environment for everyone.
